



Why do Fellowship Groups meet?

Colossians 2:6-7 says: "*...just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live in him, rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness.*"

With this in mind, the goal of Fellowship Groups is to learn to live with Christ as Lord over every area of our lives.

What do Fellowship Groups do?

So that we can encourage one another to live with Christ as Lord, Bible study and prayer are at the heart of the group meetings, along with plenty of time to get to know one another better (usually over coffee and cake!) and share our lives together.

When do Fellowship Groups meet?

Most groups meet weekly on Wednesday evening, but there are also groups meeting on Tuesday morning, afternoon and early on Wednesday morning. What is the point of Church? Why do you come to Church? Our world today is utterly committed to individualism and self-indulgence. Everyone assumes that their own desires and preferences are somehow sacred, and no one else has any right to tell someone else how to live life. So why not just do your relationship with God in the privacy of your own home where you can do it any way you want? In 1 Corinthians the Lord tells us He has brought us together for His own purposes, for full-blown, God-centred life *together*. What does that look like? How do we do it when we all battle with self-centredness and selfishness? And why would anyone want to join something like this the calls us to put others first? We'll be exploring what Church should look like, and how we can be a part of it.
