OPTION A – Sharing the gospel across cultures within our community

(Maurice Sinclair, Nick Devas and Ann Ruck)

We will learn from the experience of pioneer missionaries who reached out to unreached peoples. We will learn how faith relates to culture and be equipped to welcome, befriend and share our faith in Jesus with people in our community from very different cultures.

OPTION B – Being a Christian at work (Oli Huggins)

What's your identity in when you're at work? Over the course of 3 seminars we'll be looking at how we can become more effective at witnessing in our workplaces, learning from the wisdom and encouragement of each other as we contend for Christ.

OPTION C – Living & Speaking for Jesus at school / college (Tom Bryant)

We'll cover three main areas about living and speaking for Jesus at school/college: 1. What does it mean? 2. What makes it hard? 3. How can we get started? We will be looking at the Bible, sharing our experiences and hearing practical advice to help us to better live and speak for Jesus as teenagers at school.

OPTION D – What to say when...? (Guest speakers including Neil Powell and Andy Weatherley)

There are some big questions that leave us stumped and seem to close down the discussion. Why does God allow suffering? Why does He send people to hell? Isn't Christianity implausible? We will think about what to say when people ask these sorts of questions.

What is TOOLBOX?

The aim of **TOOLBOX** is to 'equip God's people for works of service' (Eph. 4:12). For three weeks (**September 14th, 21st and 28th**) Fellowship Groups won't meet in their usual format. Instead, there will be four streams of seminars, each around the topic of talking to others about Jesus (see opposite). Each stream aims to give practical help on an aspect of Christian evangelism so that we may serve Christ and His church more effectively.

Who is TOOLBOX for?

TOOLBOX is for everyone – not just for those who meet regularly in Fellowship Groups, but for anyone in the church family who wants to dig a little deeper into a particular issue.

What will TOOLBOX look like?

We will begin with coffee and cake served from 7:45pm. We will then divide into our seminar streams (8.00-9.30pm). In each stream, there will be teaching from the front, opportunity to discuss and ask questions, and finally to pray together.
