BLESSING

Jeremiah so far

- 1: Our God speaks through Jeremiah to tear down and to build up.  
 2-6: Our God loves his people deeply, yet finally tears them down because of their ceaseless adultery.  
 7-10: Our God lives with his people, forgiving them through sacrifice, yet finally tears them down because of their complacent idolatry.  
 11-17: Our God commits to his people in relationship in order to bless, yet finally tears them down because of their stubborn wickedness.

**Question: Has God's word failed? Has God been forced to abandon his people, and his covenant, because of their sinful hearts?**

1. Our God is God and he does as he pleases (1-10)
    - a. Our God is the potter; we are the clay (1-6)
    - b. He loves mercy (7-8)
    - c. He hates sin (9-10)
  2. Our God speaks and calls people to respond to his warning (11)
  3. Our God shows us that the problem is with our hearts and it is worse than we can imagine (12-23)
    - a. The problem is our hearts (12)
    - b. Israel, with all her privileges, turns her back on God (13-17)
    - c. Israel, with all her privileges, tries to kill God's prophet (18-23)
